DriveSpace is designed to quickly list the capacity, space used, used percentage, free space, and free percentage, of a number of drives on your system.

Distribution

This program is free to distribute and share on an unlimited number of your own computers, as long as it is not modified in any way. I, David Grund, maintain the ownership and distribution rights, which may change in future versions.

DriveSpace Vers 1.1

Program Installation

This program is manually-installed.

1. Create a directory for the sole use of DriveSpace.
2. Copy the distribution files into that directory. They are:
 - 2.1. DriveSpace.Bat
 - 2.2. DriveSpace.deps.json
 - 2.3. DriveSpace.dll
 - 2.4. DriveSpace.exe
 - 2.5. DriveSpace.pdb
 - 2.6. DriveSpace.runtimeconfig.json
 - 2.7. DriveSpace.pdf
3. MOVE the batch file that is provided OUT of the distribution directory, and into your command path (where all of your other batch files reside).
4. Modify that batch file as described below.

Tailor DriveSpace.Bat

The initial batch file looks like this:

```
@Echo off
Rem DriveSpace
Rem Last modification: September 19, 2026.
N:
CD \winapps\DriveSpace
drivespace.exe cdaklswx
pause...
```

1. Change the last modification date to the current date. You will be glad you did.
2. The N: represents the drive letter that contains the directory that you created for the sole use of the program.
3. The line that starts with CD: replace winapps with the name of the directory that you created for the sole use of the program.
4. Finally, the line that starts with drivespace.exe: the parameter (cdaklswx) should be replaced by the drive letters that YOU want to display statistics on.

The program does not use the Windows Registry. If you wish to uninstall, simply delete the batch file, the directory, and its contents, and the uninstall is clean and complete.
